

Wayland Township

Wayland Township residents have access to curbside recycling collected every other Friday. Contact Allegan County Resource Recovery at 269-673-5415, ask for Ben Williams for sign up information. Allied Waste will drop off **one** bin. Overflow material must be put in additional bins provided by the resident. Materials must be sorted into the following groups. Read below on what materials are accepted. A household can place as many bins needed at the curb!

Group #1

Put glass, empty aerosol cans, kitchen metals, plastic items and batteries this bin.

Glass—Empty clear, green or brown glass.

Metal—Cans must be rinsed out, empty aerosol containers.

Batteries—Seal in Ziploc bags, household only.

Plastics— #1 thru #5 and #7, plastic bottles and jugs empty and rinsed out, plastic grocery bags #2 & #4.

No Foam! Read below in other materials to find out where foam is accepted.

Magazines, phone books, flattened cardboard & boxboard, paper bags, newspaper, office paper and junk mail can be commingled in this bin.

Paperboard—Cereal snack & tissue boxes, remove liners, no wax coated paperboard.

Junk Mail—Envelopes, flyers, brochures, post cards.

Magazines, Phone Books & Catalogs
Cardboard & Paper

Bags—Flatten cardboard & cut into pieces, no wax coated cardboard.



Call the Allegan County Health Department if you have **Household Hazardous Waste**, like: **household batteries, oil-based paints, cleaners, expired or unwanted medications, pesticides, solvents, compact fluorescent lights, automotive and other chemicals.** Bring us your **mercury thermometers** for an exchange! Appointments for drop off are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays during regular business hours. **Call 269-673-5415 for your appointment.**



Used motor oil can be recycled! Call **Stoddard Oil**, 3456 12th St., Wayland 269-792-6591 to check the hours to drop off used oil. Don't mix other wastes with oil.

OTHER MATERIALS

Large shipping cartons, foamed polystyrene (no packing peanuts), **appliances** and **tires** can be taken to the monitored depot site: Salem Twp. Transfer Station, 29th St. near Burnips, 1/4 mi. south of 142nd Ave. You must present your resource recovery card. This site is closed January and February. Call for hours.
